THE BIBLE IN HISTORY:

Moral foundations of Western legal systems, movements like abolition of slavery, civil rights, and social reform, the Bible has inspired visionaries, leaders, and entire nations.








THE BIBLE IN CULTURE:

From Shakespeare to Tolstoy... Phrases like "by the skin of your teeth" or "a thorn in the flesh" come straight from its pages. Influence echoes in music, art, politics, and even everyday speech.







The Bible and Christian Faith:

Not just a historical document or a moral guide—it's the Word of God. It tells the story of creation, fall, and restoration to God through Jesus, and how we are to live as disciples.







WE CAN TRUST THE BIBLE AS INERRANT BECAUSE GOD CANNOT LIE

- Does Science contradict it, can we believe in the miracle stories as reality?
- That's where the doctrine of inerrancy comes in.





It doesn't mean we understand everything, *or even obey it*, still things to grapple with.

Phil 2:14 do everything without complaining or arguing...???







Inerrancy means that the Bible, in its original writings, is without error in all that it affirms—whether it's about God, morality, or history.





WHY IS THAT IMPORTANT?

- If the Bible is truly God's Word—spoken through human authors but ultimately from Him—then it must reflect His character.
- And God is not mistaken. He does not lie. He does not mislead.





Some things in the bible are

NARRATED/RECORDED ACCUTATELY BUT NOT ENDORSED.

- 1. Lot Offering His Daughters (Genesis 19:8)
- 2. Jephthah's Vow and Sacrifice (Judges 11:30–39)
- 3. David's Polygamy (2 Samuel 5:13; 1 Chronicles 3:1-9)
- 4. Solomon's Idolatry (1 Kings 11:1-10)
- 5. Jobs comforters Job 42:7
- 6. Saul seeks out witch at Endor 1 Sam 28





For disciples of Jesus, the significance hinges on one central conviction: **that when God speaks through Scripture**, **He speaks truth**. That's why inerrancy isn't a side issue—it's the safeguard of our trust in the very heart of the gospel.

"The inerrancy of Scripture means that Scripture in the original manuscripts does not affirm anything that is contrary to fact"

(Systematic Theology, p. 90). Wayne Grudem.





- This does not mean that the Bible uses modern scientific language, modern grammar (Ps. 113:3).
- Inerrancy does not mean that every copy or translation of the Bible is without error, nor that the biblical authors were all knowing or used modern categories of thought.
- Inerrancy also does not stop the presence of literary genres, symbolic language, or approximations (e.g., 1 Kings 7:23's measurements). Instead, it insists that Scripture speaks truly according to its intended purpose and genre.
- All the Bible affirms is true, trustworthy, and divinely authoritative.





MATTHEW'S GENEALOGY



2. Pick a time and a place

Are you a morning person or night owl? Do you like quiet places or bustling coffee shops? Do you learn by watching, listening, or reading? Do you sometimes read paper and other times digital?

Once you decide on a routine that works for you, start one of these Bible Plans or consider a paper Study Bible.


