


Paul's urgent concern **AND SO** unusually there is no good news for these guys!

No real affection, no warm greetings: the Galatians are abandoning the true gospel for a distorted one.

Paul writes to the Galatians—and he's shocked.

- Not by persecution.
- Not by culture.
- But by the church.

**SET FREE: LIVING IN THE SPIRIT OF GRACE**



- Grace and peace come from God through Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins.
- Salvation is the finished work accomplished by Christ, rooted in God's will, **NOT** human effort.

CHRISTIANITY IS THEREFORE NOT  
ABOUT SELF-IMPROVEMENT BUT A  
DIVINE RESCUE.





That's why prayer becomes vital – it is reaffirming our dependency on God

# LEGALISTS & “JUDAIZERS”

- They taught that faith in Christ was not enough for salvation - unless Gentile believers also obeyed the Jewish law, especially circumcision and Mosaic regulations.
- They undermined the gospel, adding human effort to what Christ had already accomplished, confusing believers and threatening their spiritual freedom.
- They were a serious distortion of the gospel, shifting trust away from **CHRIST ALONE** and back onto law-keeping, which could never justify anyone before God.

# Paul seems shocked that the Galatians are turning to a “different gospel.”

- One of the strongest points: curse against anyone who preaches another gospel, even angels.
- Sincerity, supernatural experiences, “anointing” nor popularity do not validate a message— truth does.
- The truth of what God has revealed in scripture.

# FALSE GOSPELS: (not preach against people)

## 1. The false gospel of “success” & material prosperity

*Paul was one of the most influential Christians ever. His ministry was possibly the most ‘successful’ of all time. However, it did not lead to material prosperity. Quite the opposite!*

# The false gospel of sexual freedom (the cultural message)

- Our culture preaches that freedom means autonomy — “It’s my body, my choice, my truth.”
- Sexual desire is treated as identity, and self-expression is elevated above self-control.
- Any limit is seen as oppression, and obedience to God is framed as harmful or outdated.
- This echoes the distortion Paul warns against: using freedom as an excuse to indulge the sinful nature (Gal. 5:13).
- Like Romans 6:1, the underlying belief is: If grace forgives, then desire defines —so why resist?



# **The gospel of grace and true freedom (the biblical response)**

- Scripture reframes the question :“What am I allowed to do?” to “Who do I belong to?”
- “You are not your own; you were bought at a price” (1 Cor. 6:19–20) — our bodies are redeemed (not evil).
- Grace does not remove God’s design; it restores us to it (Rom. 6:1–2).
- True freedom is not the right to do whatever we want, but the power to live as we were created to live.
- Sexual holiness is not repression, but worship — honouring God with our bodies as temples of the Holy Spirit.
